



Update on xThink in Croatia

16 April 2007 — Those who watch xThink's worldwide progress are aware of xThink's activity in Croatia (especially if they speak Croatian!). Since late 2006, xThink has been building a partnership with Croatia's Ministry of Science, Education, and Athletics, which is led by Dr. Dragana Primorca.

On Saturday March 24, 2007, Dr. Primorca and Deputy Minister Dr. Dragan Schwarz, signed an agreement with Drazen Vidovic, xThink Marketing Director. Licensing agreements are in place for both xThink Calculator and MathJournal. The signing ceremony took place at the Marjan primary school in Split, which is the fast-growing and second-largest city in Croatia.

xThink's revolutionary software for pen-based mathematics will benefit over 3,000 Croatian schools beginning with 1,300 schools immediately. This nation-wide initiative represents the first opportunity for xThink to contribute to the educational success of an entire generation of mathematicians, engineers, scientists, and a myriad of other professionals.

The key to xThink's contribution is, "the power of the pen." xThink products, especially MathJournal, literally remove barriers between the people and the power of the computer. This goal is achieved through pen-based recognition of two-dimensional math expressions.

The decades-old dream of pen-based math on "intelligent paper" has come true with xThink products. Students and professionals immediately start solving and visualizing math problems, because they write math expressions based on the handwritten math conventions they have learned since childhood. (With other math software, students must learn custom keystrokes, menu selections, and mouse clicks.)

The user writes complex math expressions in MathJournal and the software generates numerical solutions, symbolic solutions, and plots. MathJournal stores constants, intervals, and functions that the user defines for repeated use. Unlike traditional math software, MathJournal automatically recognizes the type of problem written, and it presents a variety of appropriate solution types, including 2D and 3D plots.

xThink provides tools for computers that are enabled for the digital pen, including the Tablet PC. The software combines powerful recognition software and mathematical algorithms to create "intelligent paper." xThink technology enables the following products:
